

5c. New motion: “Fight the cuts”

Conference believes

1. That is no “need” whatsoever to any cuts to jobs or services.
2. That there is a vast amount of money in society. In the last two years the thousand richest people in Britain have increased their wealth by £137 billion.
3. That what the Coalition government is doing is redistributing wealth from the working class and the poor to the rich. We are paying for a crisis we did not cause – causing a fresh economic crisis.
4. That our aim should be taking hold of the wealth of the rich, business and the banks to fund the jobs, education and services we need, reorganising society in the interests of the majority.

Conference further believes

1. That the only way to stop the cuts is through mass direct action, including industrial action. The fantastic November 30 public sector showed what is possible. Whatever the fate of the pensions dispute, there will be more cuts and more fight back.

Conference resolves

1. To oppose all cuts to jobs and services.
2. To demand heavy taxation of the rich and full nationalisation of the banks to fund decent jobs, education and services for all.
3. To fight for a government based on the organised labour movement which carries out these measures in the interests of workers, students and the majority of society.
