1. Welcome

Student Councillors welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced themselves.

2. Student Representative Officer Update

President Maev McDaid gave an update on what they had been doing recently. This included working on the National Demo, Black History Month, University Challenge and Building Project.

3. Student Council Update

Chair gave an update of Student Council. Council discussed the feedback from the forums and agreed to pass Zero Tolerance to Board of Trustees with a couple of amendments.

4. Policy Cycle
